Ian Cornnor serves as Financial Analyst (FA) for the INTERPOL Washington, U.S. National Central Bureau (USNCB). Additionally, his contribution to tracking obligations, spending, and overhead funds as well as accurate reporting is instrumental to the INTERPOL Washington as the Servicing Agency and to our partner the Department of State (DOS) Office of Counterterrorism/Programs (CT/P), the Requesting Agency.

Prior to joining INTERPOL Washington, Ian worked in the Office of the Chief Financial Officer for the District of Columbia Government as Financial Analyst for the General Operations Cluster (GOC).
